Parents: Congratulations on the birth of your child!

If you are thinking of the Baptism of your child, the sooner we hear from you the better! Please talk to our Parish Secretary, Annette, our Parish Catechist, Natalie, or our Parish Priest, Fr Michael Murphy.

Please Note: *an infant should, if possible, be baptised within the first weeks after birth. Therefore, we need to hear from you, and you need to be aware of the Formal Stages that lead to Baptism.*

We in Kilnamanagh and Castlevew Parish want to help you make your child's Baptism an occasion of great joy. In order to make this possible, we need your full co-operation with our arrangements for the Sacrament of Baptism, which are based on Dublin Diocesan Policy.

We are delighted that you are thinking about the Baptism of your child. We want to support you in every way we can, and we first of all invite you to attend the Information Meeting For Baptism.

Our approach to the Sacrament of Baptism involves a number of Stages, and the Information Meeting is the first. The other Stages are on the Baptism Schedule 2020.

Please book a place for the Information Meeting For Baptism as soon as possible. There is a Booking Form. For instance, if you are thinking of presenting your child for Baptism in February or March 2020, you need to attend the Information Meeting For Baptism Scheduled for 22nd January 2020.

Please also fill out the Request For Baptism Form. We need a copy of your child's birth certificate with this.

Please Note: all bookings for Baptism are provisional. The number we can accommodate on a particular date is limited. We hope to be able to confirm dates after the Information Meeting For Baptism.
