Please invite people you know to attend the Holy Week Liturgies. On Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus.
Some of the Liturgies of Holy Week alternate between the two churches; so, for this year:
The Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper will take place in St Kilian's on Holy Thursday at 7.30 pm.
The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion will be celebrated in both churches on Good Friday at 3 pm, with Stations of the Cross in St Kevin's at 7.30 pm.
The Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night will be celebrated in St Kevin's at 10 pm.
Mass on Easter Sunday will be in St Kevin's at 10 am, and in St Kilian's at 12 noon.
4. The Share Collection will be taken up at the Offertory. Its primary purposes are to meet the administration costs of the Diocese and to support disadvantaged parishes.

May God bless us this Holy Week in Kilnamanagh-Castleview Parish and may it be a time of renewal and new hope for each one of us.
