

# **Parish Notices [All Saints 1 11 20]**

- 1. We continue with the Online Schedule for the week ahead, with the addition of Evening Prayer on Saturday at 6 pm.**
- 2. Thanks to all who contribute to the 3 Collections at Weekend Masses.**
  - You can contribute electronically at any time using the Donate facility on the Parish Website.**
  - You could also contact the Parish Office to make an arrangement to bring your Offerings to the church.**
  - Sincere thanks to those who already do so.**

- 3. November is the month of the Holy Souls when we honour and pray in a special way for all our loved ones who have died. The tradition of the Altar List Of The Dead is where we write out the list of names of deceased loved ones whom we want to remember in prayer. The Altar List Of The Dead is included in the prayers for the dead at Mass on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, Feast of All Souls, and all throughout the month of November, as well as on the First Fridays through the year.**

**Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, this cannot happen in the usual way this year. What we suggest, therefore, is that you fill out and submit the digital Altar List Of The Dead, which you will find on the Homepage of the Parish Website.**

**Or, you can submit your own List in your own envelope to the Parish Office. (Please note that the Parish is not providing envelopes this year due to Covid-19.)**

**Church gates at St Kevin's may be closed over, but they are never locked. There is a post box at the back door to the Sacristy and Office at St Kevin's where you can leave post.**

- 4. Tomorrow, Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> November is All Souls Day. The Mass broadcast at 10 am will be offered for all whose names are on the Altar List of the Dead. Mass on Friday will also be offered for the Holy Souls.**

- 5. This November we have a Prayer Station by the gates of our 2 churches, at the railings. There you can pause at any time you are passing and say a prayer for your deceased loved ones.**
- 6. Further prayers for the dead that can for instance be used at a visit to your loved one's grave, are available via the QR code or on the Parish Website.**
- 7. In November we also have the Mass of Remembrance for Deceased Family and Friends who have died during this past year. This special Mass will take place in St Kevin's on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November at 7.30 pm. The Mass will not be open to the public, but will be broadcast on the Parish Webcam.**
- 8. We have a new newsletter initiative in the Parish. This eNewsletter is being sent to those who have registered as parishioners, roughly 140 families or individuals. If you wish to receive it, fill out the registration form on the homepage of the Parish Website.  
The eNewsletter can also be downloaded from the Parish Website.  
We hope to produce one roughly each month.**
